### How to Make a Circle Book

Print the circles you want to use in your circle book single sided. For the black and white copies print black and white. For the color copies, print in color. You can print on thicker paper like cardstock if you desire.



Cut out all the circles carefully.



Color the black and white circles if using them.

Fold carefully down the center of each circle.



Glue the left back of the first circle to the right back of the second circle. Glue the left back of the second circle to the right back of the third circle. Continue until you are at the last circle and glue the left back to the right back of the first circle.



You can insert a paper clip to hang your circle book.

### Other Ways to Use These Printables

These printables can be used in other ways.

- You can print the pages to use as a mini poster for family devotion or class time.
- You can glue the pages to construction paper and make a big Easter book.
- You can glue the circles on in order on a big poster board.

Jesus' disciples could not stay awake to pray with Jesus. They fell asleep.




# Mark 14:26-42

Jesus was arrested and taken to the High Priest Caiaphas where the Jewish leaders had gathered. They found him guilty of claiming to be God.




# John 18:12-40
