Read James 3:1-2
Why is being a teacher in the Kingdom of God a sobering responsibility?
Who do you know that controls their tongue well? Do they ever slip?
Why is it so hard to control your tongue?
Read James 3:3-12
Think of your own tongue as you answer these questions.
Why is the tongue like a bit in a horse's mouth?
Why is the tongue like a rudder on a ship?

Why is the tongue like a small spark starting a forest fire?
Why is the tongue like a wild animal?
The Lord is helping us to see how powerful the tongue is. When we praise God, but curse men we are able to see that we need help taming our own tongues.
Jesus explains why we need help. And what the problem is.
Read Matthew 12:33-37
How does your heart control the words you speak?
When you have said something wrong or inappropriate or unkind, what should you deal with heart or speech? Why?
Exactly! We need to ask Jesus to change our hearts. The issue is a heart issue. When our heart is thankful and full of love, our words come out gracious and kind.
Read James 3:13-18
Contrast earthly wisdom with God's wisdom.




Do not be afraid. God will strengthen and help you. He will uphold you with His Victorious Right Hand (Isaiah 41:10)





