## **Books Lovely Books**



How can you recognize a homeschooling family?

There are bookshelves lining the walls everywhere!

Homeschoolers recognize the educational and recreational value of good books. Most of us tend to invest more in good books than in curriculum.

#### Students who love reading will thrive and succeed throughout their whole lives.

The question we often ask is "What books should my children read?"

Over the years, I have collected books titles and created several reading lists for homeschooling families. This book is a collection of book lists for teens and preteens, middle to high school.

#### **High School Reading**

When it was time for high school, I stopped to think about what books I wanted my teens to read. I made a list of classic literature and great works that my teens would enjoy. I also chose books that would benefit them spiritually. I built one-credit high school courses around those books.

Years later, I see the good fruit in my adult children. They are articulate, creative, and full of wisdom. Reading good books is truly a remarkable way to educate your children. It also gives them a lifelong hobby: reading!

#### **How to Use Reading Lists**

These reading lists are extensive, though there is some overlap. Your teen will never be able to read all these books. But, what fun they could have trying!

The Young Adult Reading List is for Middle Schoolers, but older teens and adults will enjoy these books, too.

Literature is divided between American, British, and all the rest of Western Literature (going way back in time).

I also included a list of Christian inspirational books and another list of classic mysteries. Children who want to grow in the Lord will enjoy the Christian Classic Reading List and those who love mysteries will find classic who-dun-its fun and well-written.

When you find an author your teen enjoys, you can offer several different options by the same author. I would let my teens chose one book from different authors I wanted them to read. So, instead of assigning them *Tale of Two Cities*, I would allow them to read one book by Charles Dickens.

Some moms print the lists and let their teens check off books as they read them. Teens might be required to read 15 or 20 books in a school year.

However you choose to use these reading lists, I believe they will be a blessing to you!
